D.B.S. FOR YOUR WORKFORCE

D.B.S. checks

We are pleased to offer our D.B.S. service at a reduced rate for those within the Changemaker Network as part of our ongoing support to the sector. Each member is provided with eight checks, free from administrative fees.

D.B.S. verification training

The best way to speed up the D.B.S. process is for your organisation to have a named individual as a verifier. Becoming a verifier is a simple process which our D.B.S. Coordinator can talk you through.

PARTNERSHIP POWER



Partnership meetings

Once every three months, members of the Changemaker Network are invited to an online meeting where each organisation is given time to share news of their exciting work, discuss any potential partnerships, and voice the need for any help or support they may require. These events provide professionals with valuable opportunities to network and build connections.

Forging new partnerships

Oxfordshire Youth invests time in getting to know the organisations in its Changemaker Network. In building these relationships, we increase our knowledge of your work and organisational goals. Not only does this enable us to provide the best support for you, but it allows us to recommend other organisations who share similar objectives in order to create valuable connections.

Networking events

At any development or training event we organise, we always prioritise the creation of networking opportunities. The power of the Changemaker Network lies in the dedicated individuals who are making a difference in their communities. Ensuring ample networking opportunities has always been, and will continue to be, a top priority.

Annual Youth Work Conference

This flagship event features workshops led by expert practitioners who generously share their experience and knowledge. Topics covered vary from year to year and have included: fundraising, youth participation, and drug and alcohol use. Networking opportunities, both facilitated and non-facilitated, are an important part of the day. Every organisation within the Changemaker Network is eligible for one complimentary ticket to the conference each year and additional tickets can be purchased at a discounted rate.

INFORMATION AND SUPPORT



Organisational directory

A directory of members was introduced as part of the 22/23 Changemaker Network. It contains information about all the organisations that wanted to be included, along with a brief overview of their work. The directory conveniently provides members with a comprehensive list of contacts, making it easier to connect with other organisations. During registration, you will be offered the option of inclusion in the directory.

Youth workers directory

One need that was identified several times during the audit was that of a list of youth workers to reach out to in times of need. This is a new aspect of the offer and we hope that Changemakers will fully invest in it, not only by searching for short-term help, but also by encouraging their team to join. Details on how this directory will work and how to sign up for it are included in the welcome email following registration to the Changemaker Network.

Specialist support groups

Within the Changemaker Network, we will be running a variety of themed support groups such as: Geographical These groups will be based on an organisation's location, such as City, Cherwell & West, or South & Vale. Changemakers from these locations will collaborate and share their work perspectives to identify trends and create innovative responses that work for local need.

Thematic These groups will bring together organisations providing similar provisions such as mental health support, open-access services, arts, and sport and fitness programmes. The goal is to share ideas on how to engage young people, involve communities, and work with partners like police, schools, and council. You can join one or more of these relevant subgroups for your organisation during registration.

PRICING

Full membership - £80

Any community group* engaging with young people in their setting can join the Changemaker Network. The annual fee is £80 (we have retained this cost as a sign of our commitment to supporting organisations through the current financial landscape) and this entitles you to all of the support offered in this information pack.

Youth clubs membership - £50

Youth clubs offering universal, or open access provision have faced exceptional challenges over recent years. Oxfordshire Youth is committing extra time and resources to helping youth clubs overcome the complex issues they face.

Our first act is to offer those organisations who deliver solely or predominantly open-access** services to young people a reduced membership fee of £50.



New organisation - FREE

Starting up something new is hard enough. If you are building a new provision for young people in Oxfordshire, we want to help you access the benefits of the Changemaker Network and offer you your first years' membership FREE. You will still have access to all of the same benefits.

* We do not strictly define what a community group is. Any organisation, community partnership, enterprise etc. providing services that can be accessed by young people would be considered a community group and able to access the benefits of the Changemaker Network **. Universal provision (or open access) is traditionally considered to be in spaces where there is no expectation for young people to participate in any given programme, project or activity. Most would recognise youth clubs as covered by this definition. Those offering fixed activities or programmes (such as specific sports, arts or creative activities) would less likely be considered universal. If you would like to discuss which membership bracket your organisation is in, please contact us using the details on the next page.
